This is a lick that clearly displays the great sound of the Mixolydian mode. We're playing over a C dominant chord, (C7, C9, C13 etc) and it is really a fun lick to play! The C Mixolydian mode contains the same notes as the F major scale. The Mixolydian mode is actually the 5th mode of the major scale, and it is one of the most useful modes in my opinion! Have fun!
